Iowa had about 25,000 German, Italian and Japanese prisoners of war during World War II. There were two main camps, Algona and Clarinda, and 19 branch camps where prisoners worked for short periods of time. 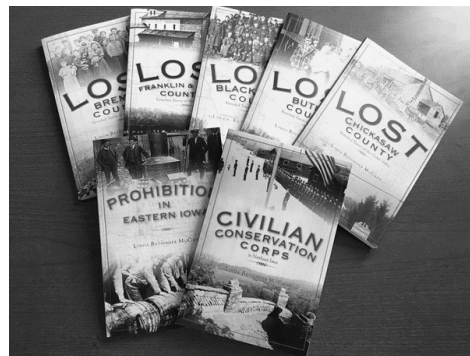
