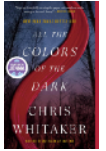
January 14 **Winter Solstice** by Rosamunde Pilcher *Friends, Holiday*

Story of five unforgettable characters, lonely and haunted strangers who find love and loyalty as a reborn family of friends during the Christmas holidays.



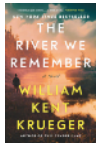
February 11 **All the Colors of the Dark** by Chris Whitaker *Thriller, Missing Persons.*

When the daughter of a wealthy family is targeted, the most unlikely hero emerges—Patch, a local boy, who saves the girl, and, in doing so, leaves heartache in his wake.



March 11 **River We Remember** by William Kent Krueger *Mystery, Veterans*

In 1958 a shocking murder in a small Minnesota town exposes deep racial tensions and dark secrets, forcing a war-scarred sheriff to confront his own demons.



April 8 **Sunflower House** by Adriana Allegri *Historical, WWII*

Woman is forced into service as a nurse at a state-run baby factory. There, she becomes both witness and participant to the horrors of a eugenics program.

Woman marries Liam “West” Weston for access to subsidized family housing while at UCLA. She also thought she’d signed divorce papers when the graduation caps were tossed, and they both went on their merry ways.



September 9 **How to Age Disgracefully** by Clare Pooley *Contemporary Women*

When a community center faces closure, an unlikely alliance of quirky seniors, daycare kids, and a teenage dad unite in unconventional ways to save their building from being sold.



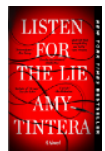
October 14 **Broken Country** by Clare Leslie Hall *Farm Life, Secrecy*
